NCF COMPETITION RULES AND COVID-19 COMPLIANCE

- NCF has an approved COVIDSafe Plan for this season. It means there are some changes to comply with Covid-19 restrictions. The plan's focus is on social distancing and hygiene. At this stage there will be no spectators at any venues. The NCF Covid Plan is available on the NCF [website](#)
- NCF Competition rules have been updated for 2020/21 and the latest version of the FIFA Futsal Laws of the Game are available on the NCF [website](#)
- Teams are allowed to borrow players from the same competition provided they are borrowed as per the 'borrowing players' rules.
- No restrictions on the number of npl/rep players in Division 1 teams. Division 2 teams are still only allowed one (1) premier league or rep player per team to be eligible to play in finals. U18 Mixed teams are allowed two (2) npl/rep players, one male and one female or two female (not two male).
- No all black uniforms.

COMPETITION FORMATS

4 Team Format

Rounds 1-9:

- Teams play each other three times

Round 10 Grand Final:

- Team 1 v Team 2 on ladder (no semi-finals)

5-6 Team Format

Rounds 1-8:

- Teams play each other – luck of the draw

Round 9 Semi-finals and play-offs:

- 1 v 4 (SF1) and 2 v 3 (SF2)

Round 10 Grand Final:

- Winner of SF1 v Winner of SF2

7-8 Team Format

Rounds 1-7:

- Each team plays each other once

Round 8 Finals Series

- 1st Place v 8th Place (Qualifying Final 1)
- 2nd Place v 7th Place (Qualifying Final 2)
- 3rd Place v 6th Place (Qualifying Final 3)
- 4th Place v 5th Place (Qualifying Final 4)

Round 9 Final Series

- Winner of QF1 v Winner of QF4 - Semi-Final 1
- Winner of QF2 v Winner of QF3 - Semi-Final 2
- Remaining games are social matches

Round 10 Grand Final:

- Winner of SF1 vs. Winner of SF2

9-10 Team Format

Rounds 1-9:

- Each team plays each other once

Round 10 Grand Final:

- Team 1 v Team 2 on ladder (no semi-finals)

11-12 Team Format

Rounds 1 - 5:

Two pools of 6 teams, each team plays each other once in each pool.

Rounds 6-8:

Pools split into top 3 and bottom 3. Top 6 teams play those teams they have not previously played. Bottom 6 teams do the same.

Round 9 Semi-finals and play-offs:

1 v 4 in each pool (SF1)
2 v 3 in each pool (SF2)

Round 10 Grand Final:

Winner of SF1 vs. Winner of SF2

REFEREES



- To avoid cash handling, NCF has incorporated referee fees into registration costs this season which means teams no longer have to pay the referee.
- Please show respect for the role that referees play in our game. It is everyone's responsibility but particularly coaches and managers as they are the role models for their players.
- No person may approach the referee at the end of a game for any purpose whatsoever without the referee's consent.
- If you have an issue with a referee, then please talk to a committee member, the referee coordinator or a venue manager. Do not confront the referee.

NCF VENUES

- NCF hires all venues and agrees to comply with conditions of hire.
- All school venues, Gold Creek School, Radford College, Daramalan College are smoke free which means no smoking on school grounds, school ovals or in school car parks.
- No Dogs are permitted at any venues.

HOT WEATHER POLICY AND FIRST AID

1

Phase 1

- 30°Celsius in Stadium
- All teams advised to increase fluid intake before and during the game.
- Game reduced to 18-minute halves.
- Two-minute drink break at 9-minute mark.

2

Phase 2

- 31-35°Celsius in Stadium
- Game reduced to 15-minute halves.
- Two-minute drink break at 7-minute mark.
- Five-minute half time break

3

Phase 3

- 36°Celsius in Stadium
- Teams given option to cancel or defer game.
- NCF Committee can also call a cancellation of all games.

First Aid is available at all venues. All venue managers and committee members are first aid qualified and Sports Medicine provides first aid at Lyneham. Please report any injury.
