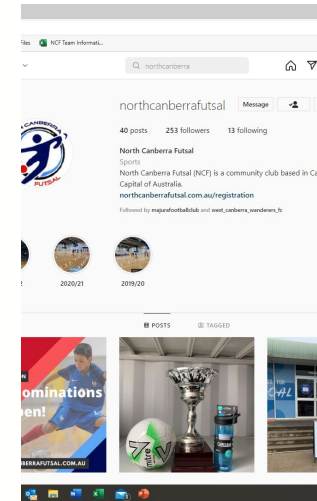
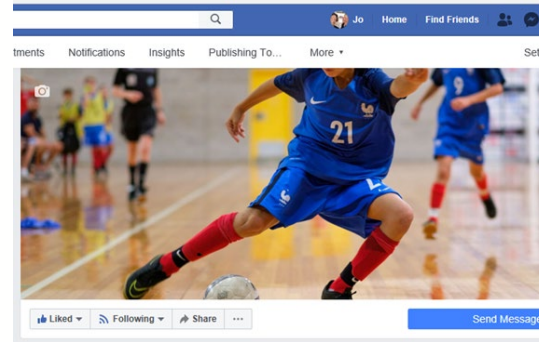
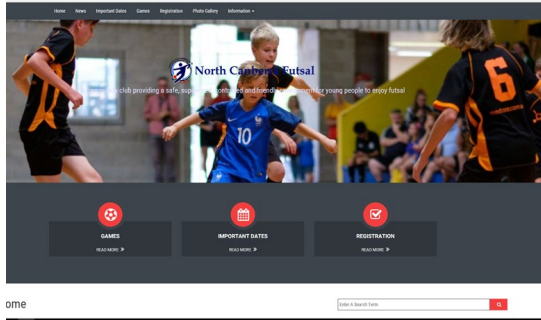




Coaches and Managers Meeting 2022

North Canberra Futsal Competition Rules

(Updated October 2022)



NCF Competition Rules

- Competition rules are available on the NCF website. FIFA Futsal Laws of the Game also available on the website.
- Teams are allowed to borrow players from the same competition provided they are borrowed as per the 'borrowing players' rules.
- No restrictions on the number of NPL/rep players in Division 1 teams. Division 2 teams are still only allowed one (1) premier league or rep player per team to be eligible to play in finals. U20 Mixed teams are allowed two (2) NPL/rep players, one male and one female or two female (not two male).
- Players can register in more than one team with NCF Committee approval but must pay both registration fees minus the CF/FFA fee for the second registration.
- The 10 goal difference rule will be applied to both the publication of results and the goals in the points table. Any score beyond a 10 goal difference will not be used to calculate goal difference.

Competition Formats

Non-competitive Competitions (U7 - U9)

- Teams play 12 rounds - luck of the draw

Competitive competitions (U10 – U20)

5 – 6 Team Competitions

- Rounds 1 – 10; Teams play each other twice
- Round 11; non-competitive (and can be used for game reschedules)
- Round 12; Semi-finals 1v4 and 2v3; Play-off 5v6
- Round 13 Grand Final; Winner SF1 v Winner of SF2

7-8 Team Competitions

- Teams play 11 rounds - luck of the draw
- Round 12; Semi-finals 1v4 and 2v3; Play-off 5v6 and 7v8
- Round 13 Grand Final; Winner SF1 v Winner of SF2

9-10 Team Competition

- Rounds 1 – 9; Teams play each other once
- Round 10 is non-competitive (and can be used for game reschedules)
- Round 11; 1v2, 3v4, 5v6, 7v8, 9v10
- Round 12; Semi-finals 1v4 and 2v3; Play-off 5v6, 7v8 and 9v10
- Round 13 Grand Final; Winner SF1 v Winner of SF2

11-12 Team Competition

- Rounds 1 – 11; Teams play each other once
- Round 12; Semi-finals 1v4 and 2v3; Play-off 5v6, 7v8, 9v10 and 11v12
- Round 13 Grand Final; Winner SF1 v Winner of SF2

Hot Weather Policy and First Aid

1

Phase 1

- 30°Celsius in Stadium
- All teams advised to increase fluid intake before and during the game.
- Game reduced to 18-minute halves.
- Two-minute drink break at 9-minute mark.

2

Phase 2

- 31-35°Celsius in Stadium
- Game reduced to 15-minute halves.
- Two-minute drink break at 7-minute mark.
- Five-minute half time break

3

Phase 3

- 36°Celsius in Stadium
- Teams given option to cancel or defer game.
- NCF Committee can also call a cancellation of all games.

First Aid is available at all venues. All venue managers and committee members are first aid qualified and Sports Medicine provides first aid at Lyneham. Please report any injury.
